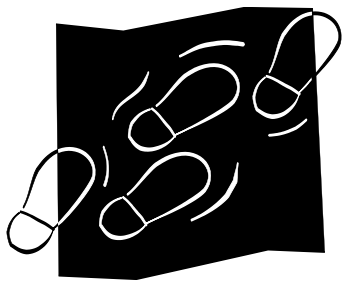

Local Area Co-ordination

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What is Local Area Co-ordination?

- ⇒ It is supported by the Fife Forum to work with individuals, their families, carers and other services to identify community groups and services which help them to maintain their independence, connect with and be part of their community for as long as is possible (for example: day services; local clubs or interest groups)
- ⇒ It responds to expressed wants and needs
- ⇒ It values the contributions people do and can continue to make towards society in general



Local area co-ordination, your pathway to services

To support this there are three Local Area Co-ordinators (LACs) working in three geographical areas Dunfermline & West Fife; Kirkcaldy & Levenmouth; Glenrothes & North East Fife (equating to one LACs per area).

LACs work alongside our communities to help identify services and groups which might support individual needs and wants. LACs will never direct people or force services on people but instead will offer information and signposting as to how individuals might fulfill their needs and wants where this is possible.

Local Area Co-ordinators:

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GLENROTHES & NORTH EAST FIFE—

incorporates Kinglassie, Glenrothes, East Neuk, Tay Coast; and the North East including Cupar & St Andrews

DUNFERMLINE & WEST FIFE—

incorporates West Fife including Kincardine, Kelty, Dunfermline

KIRKCALDY & LEVENMOUTH—

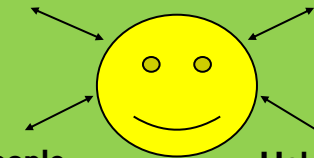
incorporates Burntisland, Kirkcaldy, Wemyss, Kennoway, Leven, Upper Largo
