GENERAL INFORMATION

There are over 90,293 people of pensionable age residing in Fife, which is around 24% of the total population. This is a slightly higher proportion than the Scottish average.

The Glenrothes Forum is part of a Fife wide network of elderly forums, which come under the umbrella of Fife Forum, who provides the local forums with funding, advice and guidance.

User Panels have been set up and are supported by staff from Fife Forum. User Panels provide a means where older people who use services can be consulted on the quality and standard of care.

An Advocacy Service provides free information, advice and support for older people in Fife.

There are also four Local Area Coordinators who work with individual and communities to identify services and groups, which help older people maintain their independence.

You can become involved, join your local Forum and make our collective views known.




