

### What is Local Area Co-ordination?

- It is supported by the Fife Forum to work with individual older people, their families, carers and other services to identify community groups and services which help older people to maintain their independence, connect with and be part of their community for as along as is possible (for example: day services; local clubs or interest groups)
- ⇒ It responds to expressed wants and needs
- ⇒ It values the contributions older people do and can continue to make towards society in general



Local area co-ordination, your pathway to services for older people

To support this there are four Local Area Co-ordinators (LACs) working in two geographical areas East & West Fife (equating to two LACs per area).

LACs work alongside our communities to help identify services and groups which

might support individual needs and wants. LACs will never direct people or force services on people but instead will offer information and signposting as to how individuals might fulfill their needs and wants where this is possible.
